OPERATION INASMUCH

Saturday, May 2nd, 10:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.

WE WILL BE DOING TWO PROJECTS... (both projects will be held on May 2nd).
1) Food drive for the Baptist Children's Homes; 2) Hosting a baby shower for a local teen and the parenting program that she has enrolled in.

We will be collecting food and supplies for the Baptist Children's Homes in the neighborhoods surrounding our church. This project is kid friendly. Our plan is to have families get out their wagons and strollers and walk door to door to ask for a donation of at least one item from their cupboard. At each home please take the time to say a short prayer for the recipient and the donor of the food. This is something the children could be taught to do. We will also have a flier to be given out that will have our church information and worship schedule.

We will need people to collect food, to pack food into boxes for delivery and also teams of people to pass of fliers the week before on Saturday, April 25th. These fliers will have a list of items needed so that households wishing to donate more than what is available in their pantry will have time to shop before we get there the next week.

Sign-up sheets will be in your Sunday School rooms. All early donations of food from our members may be placed in the Adult I Sunday School room (next to the ladies rest-room upstairs). Money donations will be appreciated to help cover the cost of printing the fliers. Turn money into the office and designate "Operation Inasmuch."

The Adolescent Parenting Program (APP) of Pender County currently has (13) girls enrolled, one teen is pregnant (due date April 15), the other teens have a child between 6 months to 4 years old. APP encourages the teens to stay in school, seek appropriate doctor care, participate in monthly peer groups, and parenting classes. Each teen is paired with a mentor to help encourage and support her. The girls earn points for participation which can then be used to "buy" items in the "incentive store." Items include clothing, toys, safety products, feeding equipment such as bottles and training cups, disposable cameras and photo albums.

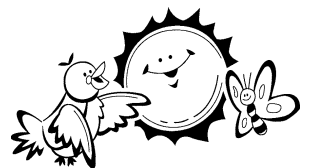
This project will be a baby shower for the pregnant teen. The shower will be held in the fellowship hall and we will need people to help prepare food, help decorate and also to attend and show your Christian love to this teen and her family. At the same time we will be collecting items for the APP incentive store. These items can be new or GENTLY used. If you would like to participate but will be unable to attend on May 2nd, then your donations can be placed in the Adult I Sunday School classroom. There will also be sign-up sheets in your classrooms.

Suggested items for the incentive store... disposable diapers, wipes, clothes (size 9 months or larger), first aid items, disposable cameras, photo albums, car seats, gift cards (Food Lion, Piggly Wiggly, Wal-Mart, Target), safety products (cabinet locks, out plugs, table corner bumpers, door handle locks), toys (infant to 4 year olds), bath toiletries (for both mother and child).

Money donations will be appreciated to help cover the cost of decorations for the baby shower. Turn money into office and designate "Operation Inasmuch."
